The Director, K.L.E. Society's Institute of Dental Sciences, Bangalore Government of Karnataka has applied for establishment of a dental college at Bangalore.

On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Karnataka has decided to issue essentially certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a dental college with 50 seats.

## It is certified that:-

- (a) The proposed Dental College is located in the proximity of 6.5 Kms General hospital and has also obtained an undertaking from the said Hospital that would facilitate training to the students of the proposed Dental College in the subject of Medicine, Surgery and Allied Medical Sciences.
- (b) The applicant owns and manages a dental clinic with 204 chairs;
- (c) It is desirable to establish a dental college in the public interest;
- (d) Minimum 125 out door Dental patients per day are available to begin with;



(e) The credibility and the financial status of the applicant has been verified;

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the dental college as per Dental Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Dental Council of India, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
